Taxes are payable to the Tax Collector at the Tax Collector's Office, Town Hall, 195 Danielson Pike, PO Box 328, Scituate, Rhode Island 02857.

The tax rate for residential real estate is \$19.156 each \$1,000 at 100% assessment ratio; for commercial/industrial/mixed use including utility is \$22.14 each \$1,000 at 100% assessment ratio; and for tangible personal property is \$40.75 each \$1,000. The tax rate on retail and wholesale inventory is exempt by State Law and by the Scituate Town Council. The motor vehicle excise tax rate is \$30.20 each \$1,000. The current rate is apportioned as follows:

Municipal Purposes	<u>33.10%</u>
Total	100.00%

All taxes are due and payable July 1, 2015, and on and after August 1, 2015 draw interest from July 1, 2015 until paid at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, as a penalty. (See schedule for installment payments.)

STATE OF RHODE ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE PLANTATIONS RESOLVED:

That the electors of the Town of Scituate qualified to vote on any proposition to impose a tax, in Town Meeting legally assembled, on this 7th day of April A.D. 2015 hereby order the levy and collection of a tax on the ratable real estate and ratable personal property in a sum not less than \$26,948,830 (twenty six million, nine hundred forty eight thousand, eight hundred thirty) nor more than \$28,026,783 (twenty eight million, twenty six thousand, seven hundred eighty three). Said tax is for the ordinary expenses and charges for the payment of interest and indebtedness in whole or in part of said town and for other purposes authorized by law.

The Tax Assessor shall apportion said tax on the inhabitants and ratable property of said Town as of the 31st day of December A.D. 2014 at twelve, midnight, according to law, and shall on completion of said levy, date, certify and sign the same and deliver to and deposit the same in the office of the Town Clerk.

Now, therefore, I the undersigned assessor of taxes of said Town of Scituate, having been duly appointed, sworn and engaged, and having given due notice as the law requires by posting a notice in a local newspaper for three weeks and posting up printed notices thereof in three or more public places in said town for more than three successive weeks next preceding the 31st day of January A.D. 2014 (the day appointed in and by said notices for bringing accounts) to wit: in the Town Clerk's Office, North Scituate Post Office, Hope Post Office, and in other places in said Town, did as of the 31st day of December A.D.

2014 at twelve o'clock midnight, assess and apportion said tax on the ratable property in said town as hereinbefore written and set forth in the preceding pages of this book, and have this 18th day of June A.D. 2014 delivered to and deposited said assessment in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Scituate.


